



DUTIES OF CDC POLL WORKERS

- Greet voters and offer them the Democrat sample ballot
- Position yourself no closer than 40 feet from the entrance of the polling place (it will be marked with a sign)
- Do not engage in negative dialog with the opponents' supporters or voters. Don't let yourself be baited into any negative conversations.
- As voters leave, thank them for voting
- Contact your relief one hour before the end of your shift
- If your replacement does not arrive contact your Precinct Captain for assistance. If you cannot reach your Precinct Captain, contact your District Leader. If you cannot reach your Precinct Captain nor your District Leader, contact Jim Lang (757) 777-6382.
